

The project “Civil Society Days – The future begins today”, having the reference number 575962-CITIZ-1-2016-1-RO-CITIZ-TT, was funded with the support of the European Union under the Programme "Europe for Citizens"

Participation: The project involved 605 citizens, of which 31 citizens from Varpalota (Hungary), 32 citizens from Bansko (Bulgaria), 24 citizens from Psary (Poland), 18 citizens from Ponte nelle Alpi (Italy)

Location/ Dates: The event took place at Petrosani City Hall (Romania) from 28/09/2016 to 01/10/2016

Short description:

The day of 28/09/2016 included the following events: registration of participants, at Petrosani City Hall's Marble Room, Civil Society's March, on 1 Decembrie 1918 Boulevard, the official opening of the project, in the European Community Park, visiting Boli Cave, a classical music concert, held at Belle Epoque Restaurant, traditional Romanian evening, at the Cafeteria of Petrosani University.

The day of 29/09/2016 included: the workshops "Causes of hostility towards immigrants" and "The benefits of volunteer work", which took place at the same time, in the Marble Room and the Local Council Meeting Room, at Petrosani City Hall, Civil Society's Fair, in the European Community Park, and traditional Bulgarian and Polish evening, at the Cafeteria of Petrosani University.

The day of 30/09/2016 included: the seminar: "Mountain sports, a form of citizenship participation", at the Sports Base of the Sports School Club in Petrosani, in the Parâng Mountains, hiking in Parâng Mountains, visiting Petrosani city, traditional Hungarian evening, at the Cafeteria of Petrosani University.

The day of 01/10/2016 included: the interactive seminar "Institutions of the European Union in the context of the emergence of Euro-skepticism and the future of Europe", the workshops "Older persons and mental health" and "Communication between generations - a way to avoid social isolation", all held at Petrosani City Hall's Marble Room, visiting Polliciono Association, traditional Italian lunch (at Pollicino Association), the farewell dinner at the Cafeteria of Petrosani University.
